

Church Business Meeting

- 1. All members are encouraged to attend, and friends of the church are welcome to attend in a non-voting capacity.

- For the sake of establishing a quorum, we will be counting members who are physically present AND members who join the meeting live via Zoom.
- Those who are in the auditorium will vote via paper ballots and those who are joining via Zoom will have access to an electronic method for voting.
- We will be voting on three recommendations for membership: John Lorenzen, Karissa Lorenzen, and Turner Russell
- We will be voting on the Board's nomination of Chad Williams to fill the remaining portion of Jim Skartvedt's term as an Elder.
- 7. We will be selecting four members from the congregation to serve on an Associate Pastor Search Committee.
- Nominations for the Search Committee will come from the floor, and members may nominate themselves or another member. If you would like to nominate someone else, please speak to the person ahead of time to make sure he or she is interested in serving.
- The meeting will also include a mid-year update on the church's financial status, as well as any other business as needed.
