



John and Jo Beth Lee – Missionaries in Tokyo, Japan August Update

John's Dad's Heart Surgery: We've been staying in Des Moines since July 25th to help with John's dad's recovery from heart surgery. Poong underwent heart surgery on July 27th. He made a slow recovery, but the day before his discharge he began battling a series of life-threatening infections. Thankfully, he has been receiving excellent care and, by God's grace, has been rescued from that threat for now. Nearly every day, John has been able to visit his dad in the hospital to encourage him in a very difficult season. In between the many quiet hours that pass, God has provided numerous opportunities to share the gospel and present devotional messages from the Scriptures. Our ongoing prayer request is for Poong to make Jesus his greatest treasure, knowing him more and more each day. Please pray that the Lees would speak boldly and lovingly all the words given to them by the Lord.

Team: John continues to co-lead the Tokyo City Team by overseeing recruitment and team care. Six of our nine team members are currently in the US on home assignment. Three continue to serve in Tokyo, seeing God provide new growth and opportunities for ministry. John and Jo Beth connect with each teammate regularly to encourage and resource them for the next step in ministry. Thankfully, our team seems to be doing well despite being spread out in the midst of the pandemic. On top of that, God continues to raise up workers for his harvest field. John has had the privilege of watching God raise up a new generation of young workers who may be part of new church planting teams in different areas of Tokyo. Please pray for God's enablement to care well for our team members. Also, we ask for wisdom, discernment and courage to welcome new team members and follow the Lord into new areas of ministry.

Church Planting: We are a church planting team that focuses on multiplying missional small groups we call Small Churches. The three churches planted in 2017-2018 continue to meet virtually over Zoom. After founding a church with our Japanese teammate and partner Michiyo, we have seen her flourish as a leader under the eldership of our teammate Shige. You might remember one of our church members, Han. In short, he has seemed to grow by leaps and bounds, recently expressing a call to full-time ministry! This was not

our suggestion, but his own idea (or the Lord's)! Alongside Han's interest in ministry, other lay members are showing spiritual maturity and growing confidence to lead. We dream of and work toward the day when one of today's lay members is commissioned to plant a new Small Church. Your prayers for the Small Church Network continue to bear fruit. Thank you! When the time comes for us to return to Japan, please pray for wisdom for us to know the best way to transition back into the Small Church community.

Outreach: Until John's dad went into the hospital, we've been watching God work in our neighborhood in Atlantic. We've been taking a small group of boys fishing, each time sharing from the scriptures and praying for one another. This has also given us opportunities to deepen our relationships with their parents and share about the Lord. If the Lord wills, we would love to see a bible study form out of us ragtag group of families. In general, God has opened several doors to new and old relationships in the community despite social distancing.

Support Raising: The lockdown this Spring put on hold our plans to visit our remaining church partners. We are beginning to schedule visits for the end of this month into September. With each visit, we want to give and receive mutual encouragement. Pray that the Lord would enable us to strengthen each church we visit to the end that they might treasure Jesus more than the day before. Please pray for healthy partnerships that bear fruit for God's kingdom. Lastly, God has recently provided some new prayer and financial partners. Thank you for praying for his provision! We continue to ask for God to provide the remaining \$1000 of monthly support.

Family Health: By God's grace, we have stayed physically healthy. Baby Bella is now four months old and growing fast. Brooke (4) and Bonnie (2) continue to grow in wisdom and stature. We pray that they would become strong women of God, loving Jesus with all their heart, soul, mind and strength. John's regular commute to the hospital in addition to our ongoing work routine has made this a physically demanding season for our family. Please pray for us to communicate well in order to adapt to frequently changing circumstances and lead our family well.
