

Church Business Meeting

We will be having a special business meeting **TODAY** to vote on the Board and Search Committee's motion that Andrew Johnson be called to serve as Associate Pastor of Student & Worship Discipleship. The meeting will begin **10 minutes after the conclusion of the worship service**.

- All members are encouraged to attend, and friends of the church are welcome to attend in a non-voting capacity.
- You have the option to attend the meeting inperson at the church OR to join the meeting from home via an online Zoom link that will be provided to the membership via an all church email.
- For the sake of establishing a quorum, we will be counting members who are physically present AND members who join the meeting live via Zoom.
- Those who are in the auditorium will vote via paper ballots and those who are joining via Zoom will have access to an electronic method for voting.

Shower Policy--Updates in bold

Policy: Effective January 2012, bridal and baby showers for individuals within our church will be initiated and given by friends of the honored individual.

Talking points:

- We affirm and celebrate bridal and baby showers. This adjusted policy will encourage individuals to sponsor and initiate the showers as a tangible outpouring of Christian love and compassion, but it will not be a core ministry of the church.
- In the event that someone is new to the church, individuals in their care group are welcome and encouraged to reach out and host a shower.
- Publicity for showers can be through the weekly bulletin and Power Point announcements, personal invitations that are mailed out or handed out at church and/or with a simple flier handed out to invite the church body. All forms of invitation should include the names of those who are serving as hosts/ hostesses.
- In order to prevent more than one shower for an honored individual, we urge those desiring to host a shower to check with any member of the women's ministry team to see if there is already a shower being planned.
- We would encourage showers given to include a devotion that Biblically affirms the gift of life, the role of the parents to train up their child, etc. for baby showers or for bridal showers, the picture of Christ and the church, the honored role of the wife, etc.
- If an individual would like to host a box shower, a point person should be designated to collect the gifts.
