

- First quarter financial update.
- We also anticipate a vote on new church members.

Procedures for Voting & Establishing a Quorum:

- All members are encouraged to participate in the meeting, and friends and regular attenders of the church are welcome to attend in a nonvoting capacity.
- You have the option to attend the meeting in-person at the church OR to join the meeting from home via this online meeting link from Zoom. The full Zoom invitation can be found at the end of this email.
- The link to join the business meeting online will also be included in the Sunday morning worship bulletin email that goes out on Sundays at 7:00 a.m.
- Please note that you will be sent to a digital "waiting room" when you
 join the Zoom meeting. This is a security measure. Please wait. The
 meeting monitor will "admit" you to the meeting shortly.
- For the sake of establishing a quorum, we will be counting members who are physically present AND members who join the meeting live via Zoom. Verification of remote attendance will be by sight in the video chat feature.
- Those who are in the auditorium will vote via paper ballots and those who are joining via Zoom will be able to vote using a voting mechanism called "Menti." The Menti link will be provided at the meeting.
